How to connect an Oculus Quest to Vivista?



1. Surf to oculus.com/setup/ and scroll down until you see the Oculus Quest.

2. Download the Oculus Link software.

7. Make sure that Oculus allows unknown sources (~ Vivista). To do this, you need to go to the settings and open the 'General' tab. At the top you will see the option to allow the running of unknown sources.





8. Next you need SteamVR. Vivista is developed with Unity, which runs on SteamVR. To install SteamVR, you first need to install Steam. Surf to <https://store.steampowered.com/about/> and install Steam.



9. After installing Steam, you can then install SteamVR. Type the search term 'SteamVR' in the search bar on the left side of your screen, after which you can select and install SteamVR.



10. Once you have completed the previous steps, you can open the Vivista Player. You only need to open the software with the computer mouse, but you don't need to select a 360° video yet. SteamVR makes sure that your headset is recognized in the background, so that a connection is established between Vivista and the headset. To select and view a 360° video, you can now use the headset and controllers.

**Note: your headset must always remain connected using the required cables.*
